Generalization - Long a is sometimes spelled **ai**, **eigh**, or **ay**: **braid**, **weigh**, **spray**. Long i is sometimes spelled **igh**: **sigh**.

1. sigh - an audible breath signaling fatigue or relief
2. right - in a direction opposite of left
3. weigh - to find out how heavy something is
4. eight - the number between seven and nine
5. detail - an item or a particular of minor importance
6. height - how tall something is
7. spray - to apply liquid in a flow of small drops
8. braid - decorative cord of multiple woven strands
9. bait - to lure with a desired object or enticement
10. grain - the hard seed of plants used as food, cereal
11. slight - small in size or importance
12. thigh - the part of the leg between the hip and knee
13. tight - in a secure or firm manner
14. raisin - a dried and shriveled grape
15. trait - a quality or characteristic
16. highway - a major, main road for public use
17. frighten - to startle or make afraid
18. dismay - to upset, perturb, or cause to lose courage
19. freight - goods shipped by air, land or sea
20. sleigh - carriage on skis to travel over ice or snow
