Generalization - Long u has two sounds, /ü/ and /yü/, and several spellings, u-consonant-e, ew, oo, ui, and u: excuse, threw, mood, cruise, pupil.

1. usual - established by custom or habit
2. huge - very big in size
3. flute - wind instrument with tube, holes and no reed
4. mood - a state of mind, an emotion
5. smooth - marked by ease; fluid and polished
6. threw - sent something flying across open space
7. afternoon - the time of day between noon and evening
8. scooter - vehicle with two wheels often pushed by foot
9. juice - liquid from a food, often fruit or vegetable
10. cruise - to sail on water or move a vehicle leisurely
11. truth - a statement proven or accepted as fact
12. bruise - injury that causes skin to darken
13. cruel - hurtful or brutal
14. excuse - to grant permission or forgiveness
15. pupil - black opening in the eye that lets in light
16. groove - a linear cut or indentation in a surface
17. confuse - to be wilder; perplex
18. humor - the quality of being funny or amusing
19. duty - what one should or ought to do
20. curfew - a set time at which people must be home
