5. graph - a visual representation of information
6. young - having few years
7. wheel - a round frame, possibly surrounded by a tire

9. belong - to fit in well with; to be in the right place
10. whiskers - long, stiff hairs on an animal's face
11. whisper - speak softly in a hushed voice
12. elephant - large land mammal with tusks and a trunk
13. white - the opposite of black
14. shrink - to become or make smaller
15. wharf - a landing where ships load and unload
16. trunk - main part of a tree or human body
17. strong - intense or overwhelming
18. blink - to open and shut eyes
19. chunk - large piece or amount
20. skunk - black and white animal, sprays terrible odor
