### Final Syllable Patterns

Generalization - The schwa in final syllables is often spelled differently: jungle, animal, eleven, summer, calendar.

1. chicken-a bird commonly raised for its meat and eggs
2. eleven-the number that comes after 10
3. brother-a man or boy in relation to other sons and daughters of his parents
4. jungle-dense, lush tropical wilderness
5. natural-found in nature, not made by people
6. together-with or in proximity to another person or people
7. calendar- a chart showing the days, weeks, and months of a particular year
8. needle-a very thin piece of metal used in sewing
9. several-more than two or three but not many
10. summer-the warmest season of the year
11. threaten-to express or warn of plans to do harm
12. caterpillar-the larva of a butterfly or moth
13. paddle-instrument used to row a boat
14. animal-a living creature with a moving body
15. pitcher-a large container, used for holding and pouring liquids.
16. shelter-something that covers or affords protection
17. oval-an egg like, elliptical shape
18. frighten-to startle or make afraid
19. mumble-to speak inaudibly or indistinctly
20. deliver-bring and hand over to the proper recipient or address
